## Becky Wright "O Holy Night"



Oklahoma-born singer/songwriter Becky Wright offers her first Christmas music releases, after five solo albums and feature spots on other projects. Wright's 2014 album, "Before the Throne: Worship & Hymns" garnered a Top 5 Nominee spot with the 2016 Independent Music Awards (NYC, Lincoln Center). Wright's 2011 "The Heart of Adoption" album produced "Duo of the Year" and "Female Songwriter of the Year" awards (Agape Fest).

A former school music teacher, Becky and her husband are blessed parents of nine children by birth, marriage, and adoption. A passionate advocate for foster kids, orphans and adoption, Becky is a frequent keynote speaker at conferences and women's ministry events nationwide in the USA, as well as in Africa and Canada. Her songs have played on hundreds of radio stations, as well as being used in churches and schools across Oklahoma.

Wright wrote her widely popular "Sweet Baby Jesus" for her students' Christmas program in 1994. Since then, the song has been used by thousands of students at other Oklahoma schools, who are thrilled to hear of the song's professional recording and inclusion on Becky's upcoming Christmas album, "Reason to Celebrate".

"O Holy Night", Wright's second Christmas release, is her all-time favorite Christmas carol. The full-length release (which will be on the album) includes a prelude of Beethoven's "Moonlight Sonata", and is "hauntingly beautiful", says Wright.
